The Downingtown Borough Council met for their reorganization meeting on January 6, 2020 at the Municipal Government Center, 4 W. Lancaster Ave., Downingtown, PA. Members present: Councilors Gazzerro, Rakoff, Dague, Van Dyk, Horstmann and Feldman. Also attending were Solicitor Christman and members of Borough staff. Mayor Maxwell called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Maxwell administered the oath of office to re-elected Councilor Lauren Van Dyk. The Honorable Jeffrey Valocchi administered the oath of office to newly elected Councilor Brad Horstmann, Beth Rakoff (Tax Collector) and re-elected Borough Council members Alex Rakoff and Phil Dague.

Mayor Maxwell called for nominations for Council President. Councilor Rakoff nominated Councilor Gazzerro, Councilor Dague seconded. Councilor Feldman nominated Councilor Dague, no second. Councilor Feldman nominated herself, no second. There were no other nominations. Mayor Maxwell asked for a vote on the nomination of Councilor Gazzerro for Council President. Councilor Gazzerro was appointed President by a majority vote.

President Gazzerro called for nominations for Council Vice President. Councilor Dague nominated Councilor Rakoff, Councilor Horstmann seconded. There were no other nominations. President Gazzerro asked for a vote on the nomination of Councilor Rakoff for Council Vice President. Councilor Rakoff was appointed Vice President by a majority vote.

President Gazzerro called for nominations for President Pro-Tem. Vice President Rakoff nominated Councilor Van Dyk. There were no other nominations. President Gazzerro asked for a vote on the nomination of Councilor Van Dyk for President Pro-Tem. Councilor Van Dyk was appointed President Pro-Tem by a majority vote.

Approval of Expenditures (Period Ending 12-31-19) – Councilor Dague made a motion to approve the expenditures for the period ending December 31, 2019, Vice President Rakoff seconded; motion carried unanimously.
