

**MINUTES
BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 3, 2021**

The Downingtown Borough Council met in regular session on February 3, 2021 at the Municipal Government Center, 4 W. Lancaster Ave., Downingtown, PA. Members present: President Gazzerro, Vice President Rakoff, Councilors Van Dyk and Horstmann. Also attending were Mayor Dague, Solicitor O'Keefe and members of Borough staff. Councilor Feldman did not attend.

President Gazzerro announced the weekly trash/recycling will be picked up on Saturday, February 6 due to delay caused by the snow.


Councilor Van Dyke reported Dane Décor will again be placing the hearts on their showroom window.
