## Did You Know?

All non-owner occupied rental units must be licensed with the Borough of Downingtown. The rental license is a two year license and all units must be inspected by the Borough Housing Officer.

The inspection is required to verify that all of the Borough's housing and safety standards have been met. The rental license fee is \$70 per rental unit every two years.

#### Is a building or zoning permit required?

A building permit is required when performing work to the interior or exterior of a home or non-residential building on a property.

Examples of work requiring building permits to the interior of an existing building include; interior renovations, modifications to or new installation of electrical, plumbing, and HVAC systems.

Examples of work on the exterior of the property requiring a zoning permit includes; new/replacement fencing, a new/replacement shed under 200 square feet, patios & pavers. <u>Click here</u> for more info.
