Downingtowntown Train Station Public Meeting

PennDOT will be hosting a Public Open House Meeting for the Downingtown Train Station project. The project plans and pertinent information will be on display **Wednesday, June 21, 2023, from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM** at the Borough Annex. The purpose of the plans display is to provide information regarding the project, including anticipated station design, layout, access; project schedule; potential temporary closures during construction; and potential impacts on environmental resources. Immediately following the Open House, a project presentation will be provided to the Downingtown Borough Council at their regularly scheduled meeting.
